Modeling microstructure 316L stainless steel by laser powder

bed fusion process

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Abstract

In this study, the prediction of grain microstructure of powder bed fused 316L stainless steel is

presented. Using a coupled fluid-thermal computational fluid dynamics model, the melt pool and

its temperature profile are computed. Then a cellular automaton code is employed to predict the

microstructural evolution. The simulation results are qualitatively consistent with experimental

observation in terms of grain size and misorientation angle.
